

Everton Football College provides a unique learning, training and playing experience for International student athletes aged 18 and over who wish to study at a world class university and continue their soccer career within an English Premier League football club environment.

The programme attracts athletes from all over the world who wish to develop their academic portfolio alongside their soccer aspirations.

Our 'Nil Satis Nisi Optimum' offer includes weekly coaching sessions ran by our fully qualified UEFA coaches and includes a full soccer season which operates over ten months per academic year. Opportunities to access cup competitions, international tournaments and take part in the National Football Youth League are also included whilst access to semi-professional soccer whilst on the programme is also possible.

As a Liverpool University student, you will live and study at one of their campuses, located in the heart of Liverpool. The programme strives to provide each student/player with life-changing experiences through first-class undergraduate and postgraduate study and soccer.

FACILITIES

Finch Farm Training Complex

Finch Farm Training Complex was opened in 2007, replacing the Club's iconic Bellefield training facility and brings every Everton team at every age group together under one roof. The complex has 10 full-size grass pitches, two full-size synthetic grass pitches, one indoor pitch and four smaller pitches. Boasting cuttingedge technology across areas like physiotherapy, medicine and performance analysis, the complex has a state-of-the-art gym, swimming pool and spa facilities. The Club's world-renowned Academy is housed alongside the first-team block. On-site classrooms, computer rooms and educational facilities allow young prospects to continue their studies and grow as footballers.

Goodison Park

Goodison has been the home of Everton Football Club since August 24, 1892. Back then, the ground could host 12,000 spectators, fast-forward to the current day the current capacity now sits at just shy of 40,000.

Everton's New Waterfront Home

Everton Football Club will soon be moving to a new stadium on Liverpool's famous waterfront, marking a major landmark in the history of the football club.

Situated on the banks of the River Mersey - on Liverpool's worldfamous waterfront - the 52,888 capacity arena has already won plaudits and accolades with its eye-catching design which brilliantly blends the modern with the traditional. The result is a football-first sporting arena that will be the envy of the world. Atmospheric. Inspirational and a home befitting a football club with rich traditions, a passionate fanbase and an ambitious future.

Walton Hall Park

Walton Hall Park is the home Everton women's first team who play in the Women's Super League. The stadium can boast of a new hybrid pitch and has a capacity of 2,200.


Vauxhall Sports Club



OUR HOME

Goodison Park has been the home of Everton Football Club since August 24, 1892.

The stadium - nicknamed 'the Grand Old Lady'- held 12,000 spectators back then. Over the years that number has fluctuated, with the current capacity around 40,000.

The record attendance at Goodison Park, however, was much higher.

On September 18, 1948 a mammoth crowd of 78,299 watched on as Everton drew 1-1 with rivals Liverpool in the old First Division..

Everton had a leading role in England's staging of the 1966 World Cup, with more games hosted at Goodison Park than any venue other than the national stadium, Wembley.

Goodison is renowned for its partisan and noisy atmosphere which intimidates opponents and intensifies under the floodlights for night matches.

HISTORY OF PLAYERS

THROUGH EVERTON

Our International programme follows the philosophy of Everton Football Club which has a rich history of developing some of England's best players within the last 20 years. Footballers such as Wayne Rooney, Ross Barkley and more recently, Tom Davies have all come through Everton's Academy.





Wayne Rooney

Rooney is regarded as the best English player of the last 20 years. Joining the Everton youth team at the age of nine, the Scouser made his professional debut for the club in 2002 at the age of 16.

Wayne spent two seasons at Everton before moving to Manchester United for £25.6 million in the 2004. Rooney won 16 trophies and became the only English player to win the Premier League, FA Cup, UEFA Champions League, League Cup, UEFA Europa League, and FIFA Club World Cup. He scored 253 goals for United in all competitions, making him the club's highest goalscorer of all time. Rooney made his senior international debut for England in February 2003, aged 17, and is England's youngest-ever goalscorer. He played at UEFA Euro 2004 and scored four goals, briefly becoming the youngest goalscorer in the history of the European Championship. Rooney later featured at the 2006, 2010 and 2014 World Cups, and was widely regarded as England's best player. He has won the England Player of the Year award four times, in 2008, 2009, 2014, and 2015. With 53 goals in 120 international caps, Rooney is England's second-most-capped player (behind Peter Shilton) and second-top goalscorer in English football history.

Ross Barkley

Ross Barkley joined Everton's academy at the age of 11 and played for the Club's youth teams.

Ross made his debut in Everton's first home match of the 2011-12 season, a 1-0 defeat to Queens Park Rangers, and was named man of the match. He scored his first goal for the club on the opening day of the 2013-14 season in a 2-2 draw against Norwich City. On 5 January 2018, Ross joined Premier League club Chelsea for a fee of £15 million, signing a five-and-a-half-year contract. He has represented England at under-16, under-17, under-19, under-20, under-21 and senior level. Ross was in the England squad for the 2014 FIFA World Cup. So far in his career Ross has won the FA Cup: 2017-18, UEFA Europa League 2018-19 and FIFA Club World Cup 2021.





Tom Davies

Tom Davies is an Everton academy graduate, having joined the club at the age of 11.

Tom was handed his Premier League debut by manager Roberto Martínez on 16 April 2016, coming on as an 83rd-minute substitute for Darron Gibson in a 1-1 draw with Southampton at Goodison Park. Tom scored his first goal for the club on the 15 January 2017 when he scored in a 4-0 league victory over Manchester City. Tom has represented England at under-16, under-17, under-19, under-20 and he also won the 2018 Toulon Tournament with England's U21 squad. Tom captained Everton for the first time on the 29 August 2018 in a 3-1 EFL Cup victory over Rotherham, becoming the youngest player to ever captain Everton Football Club. In 2023, Tom left Everton to join fellow Premier League outfit, Sheffield United.



HISTORY

Everton Football Club has a glorious history.

It is one based on a rich tradition of innovation and bravery and a commitment to our motto, Nil Satis Nisi Optimum - nothing but the best is good enough.

The Club, also known as the Blues or the Toffees, was created as St Domingo's in 1878 before taking on the title of Everton Football Club one year later.

Founding members of the Football League in 1888/89, the Club won its first English title two years later in 1890/91. Everton have been crowned champions of England nine times, most recently winning the league in 1986/87, when Howard Kendall's team finished nine points ahead of Liverpool.

Only three clubs - Manchester United, Liverpool and Arsenal - have won more English league titles than Everton.

The Club has played the entirety of its domestic league football at the highest level, aside from one season in the 1930s and three more during the 1950s. No club in the country has contested more top division matches than Everton.

Everton have also won the FA Cup - English football's premier knockout competition - five times, reaching the final on a further eight occasions.

The Club enjoyed its most successful period during the mid-1980s, when Kendall's side were league champions twice in three years and lifted the FA Cup in 1984. Everton won the European Cup Winners' Cup in 1985, comprehensively beating Rapid Vienna 3-1 in the final.

Everton's rivalry with neighbours Liverpool is the longest running top-flight derby in England. The teams have met on more than 230 occasions since their first encounter in 1894. Less than a mile separates the clubs' homes. Goodison Park and Anfield.

There have been many legendary figures throughout Everton's history but one man's name stands head and shoulders above the rest - the iconic Dixie Dean.

The English game's greatest goalscorer, Dean struck a phenomenal 383 goals in 433 matches for Everton between 1925 and 1937. He hit 60 in 1927/28 - the most in a single season in English top-flight history.


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
